Sermon Title: Tackling God Sized Task

Scripture: Joshua 5: 13-15, 6:20, 27

Read 13 – 15

- When we cross over Jordan God will put God sized Task Before us.
- We Don't know when these task arrive

Verse 13 – Joshua surveying Jericho

- We need to get off alone and survey where we are spiritually – prepare for our task
- Drawn sword – God size task was military – “Do not be afraid” **God connected with Joshua. He /God was using Joshua's Language.**
- Are you for us or against us? **Who is in control of your life?**

God is in Control – “No, rather I indeed come.....” Verse 14 (first part)

Three Things to do when faced with a God sized Task

1. Recognize the task is from God.

- a. Joshua fell down in awe **God is BIGGER than me!! Verse 14**
- b. Recognize that God sized task are just that “God Sized” Read Chapter 6: 2-4 – God didn't want Joshua to use “his” military might.....this doesn't make sense it's beyond me!!!

2. Go Before the Lord

- a. Joshua asked what he should do. **PRAY!!! VERSE 14**
- b. Go to a Holy Place. Be in God's presence. Find strength among God's people. **Verse 15**
- c. When faced with God sized task don't go it alone.

3. Obey

- a. Joshua did it. It didn't make sense but he did what God wanted him to do.

Conclusion: When you are obedient to what God wants you to do (the task before you) God will bless you. He will equip you. He will give you everything you need to do it His way.

Joshua 6: 27 - We **don't do it for fame we obey God because we love Him and we make Him Lord of our lives.**
